Course objectives	<p>The objective of the course is to introduce basics of law, insurance and ethics which will be applied in logistics. To understand basic thoughts, examples and case studies will be provided. Students will learn about legal norms and regulations, evaluation of possibilities of product insurance, means of transport and forwarding companies to eliminate risks connected with logistic process. They will also learn to draw social responsibility in logistics, they will study ethical code and ethical behaviour. At the end of the course, various issues connected with ethical issues in logistics and in supply chain, will be illustrated and discussed.</p>
